Fred Olsen Avenue, located in front of the beach in the town of **Arrecife on the island of Lanzarote**, has been completely renovated to become a pedestrian promenade free of vehicle traffic. This intervention has transformed the area into a friendlier, more accessible and attractive space for pedestrians, promoting urban life by the sea.

White concrete urban furniture has been installed along the entire avenue, **including Kube Curve benches, Lisa and Ficus chairs, Volga benches with backrests, Kube Nin litter bins, and Milan luminaires**, which provide efficient lighting with a contemporary design.

Thanks to their concrete construction, these elements are highly resistant to the island's climatic conditions, such as salt air and high temperatures, and require no maintenance. The result is a modern, comfortable, and durable environment that enhances the quality of the public space in a privileged seafront location.
