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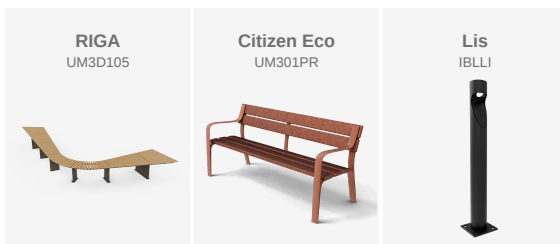

Jaén (Spain)

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Need / Problem: The municipal garden required renovation to improve resting areas and ensure adequate lighting during low-light hours.

Solution: Installation of new street furniture and pedestrian lighting integrated into the surroundings.

Result: A more comfortable, accessible and safer space for everyday use by residents and visitors.

In Lopera, a municipality in the province of Jaén, the municipal garden has been renovated to improve the quality of the public space and strengthen its role as an area for walking, relaxation and social interaction.

The project includes new **RIGA benches** from the **Benito Design+ collection**, bringing a contemporary and refined appearance to the site. Their design helps organise seating areas and create more comfortable spaces throughout the garden.

In addition, **Citizen ECO benches** have been installed in other areas, expanding seating options and adapting to different points along the route.

The project is completed with **LIS bollard lights**, providing appropriate pedestrian lighting in low-light areas, improving visibility and enhancing the sense of safety.

The result is a more functional, pleasant and welcoming municipal garden that can be enjoyed throughout the day.



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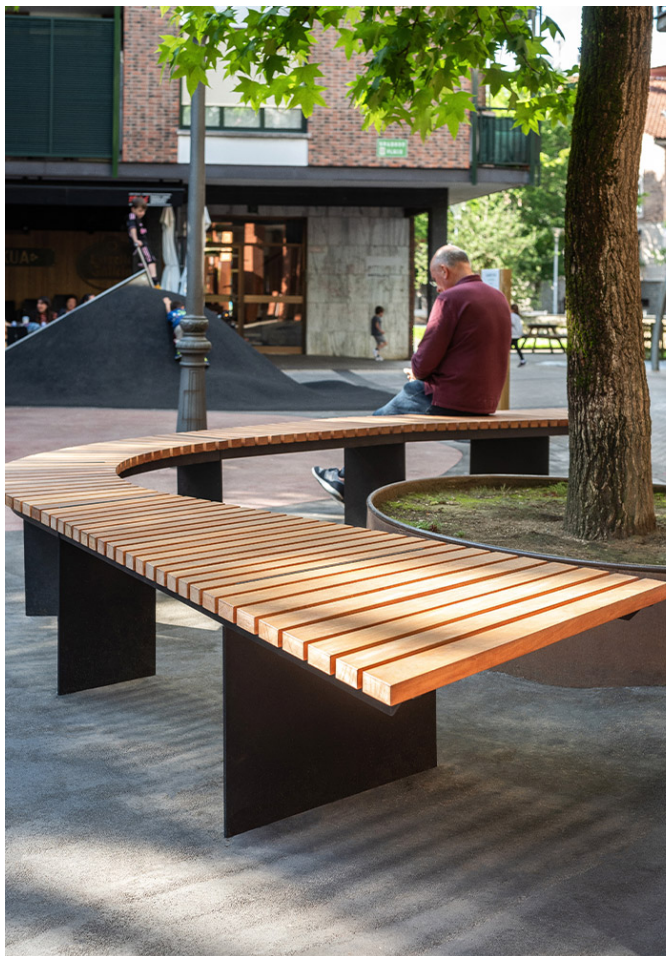
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Astigarraga, a municipality located a few kilometers from San Sebastián, of which it was part until the late 1980s, is known not only for being the epicenter of Basque cider tradition but also for its growing popularity in recent years.

Benito Urban and the architecture firm LZB Arkitektura and Hiritik At have been selected to carry out this project due to their ability to create customized solutions.

The project consists of a comprehensive custom design of urban furniture and a playground that will allow the remodeling of the Sagardo plaza in Astigarraga, as the area already had benches and a park. The local government board approved the remodeling of this space with the aim of recovering its character and at the same time turning it into an area to be enjoyed; all this inspired by the sinuous shapes of the ground.



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
