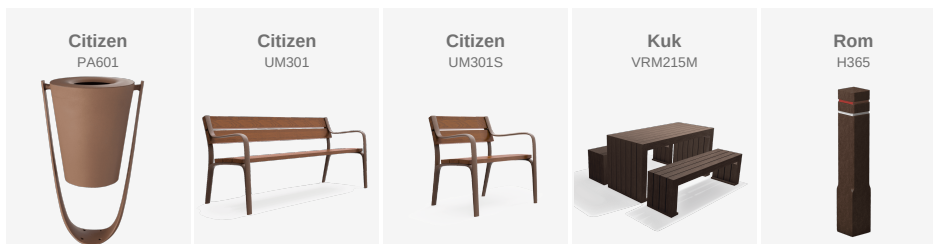




In Fuerteventura, the urban furniture is being renewed with Citizen benches and bins, designed by Eugeni Quillet, and recycled ReBnew elements are being incorporated, creating a sustainable and welcoming environment.

Fuerteventura (Spain)

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In the village of **Tuineje**, located on the island of **Fuerteventura**, a major renovation of the **urban furniture** has been carried out with the aim of improving public space for residents and tourists. All the benches in the village have been replaced with **Citizen wooden benches and chairs**, combined with **Citizen litter bins**, models designed by **Eugeni Quillet** in an elegant **Marson** color. In addition, the municipality has committed to **sustainability** by incorporating furniture made from recycled material, known as **ReBnew**. This furniture includes **Pik picnic tables** and **ROM bollards**, which are also used for traffic control in the city center. The renovation aims to create a more **modern and comfortable** environment for residents and tourists visiting the village this summer, providing a more functional and **environmentally friendly** space.
