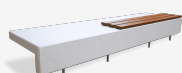

Villa di Massenzio is located between the second and third mile of the ancient Appian Way and consists of three main buildings. It also has a garden. It is where a group of benches from the Ela model, made of concrete and wood, have been installed. This site is named after the Roman Emperor Massenzio and is one of the most visited sites in the Eternal City.

The benches are made with a water-repellent reinforced concrete seat moulded with a matt stainless-steel structure for anchorage. They have wooden slats and backrests.

The ELA bench is made from precast reinforced waterproof polished granite white concrete. A matte stainless steel structure anchors it to the ground. To make it more welcoming, the seat and backrest are made of wood with different slats. Its modern style makes it suitable for all types of environments.



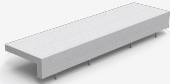

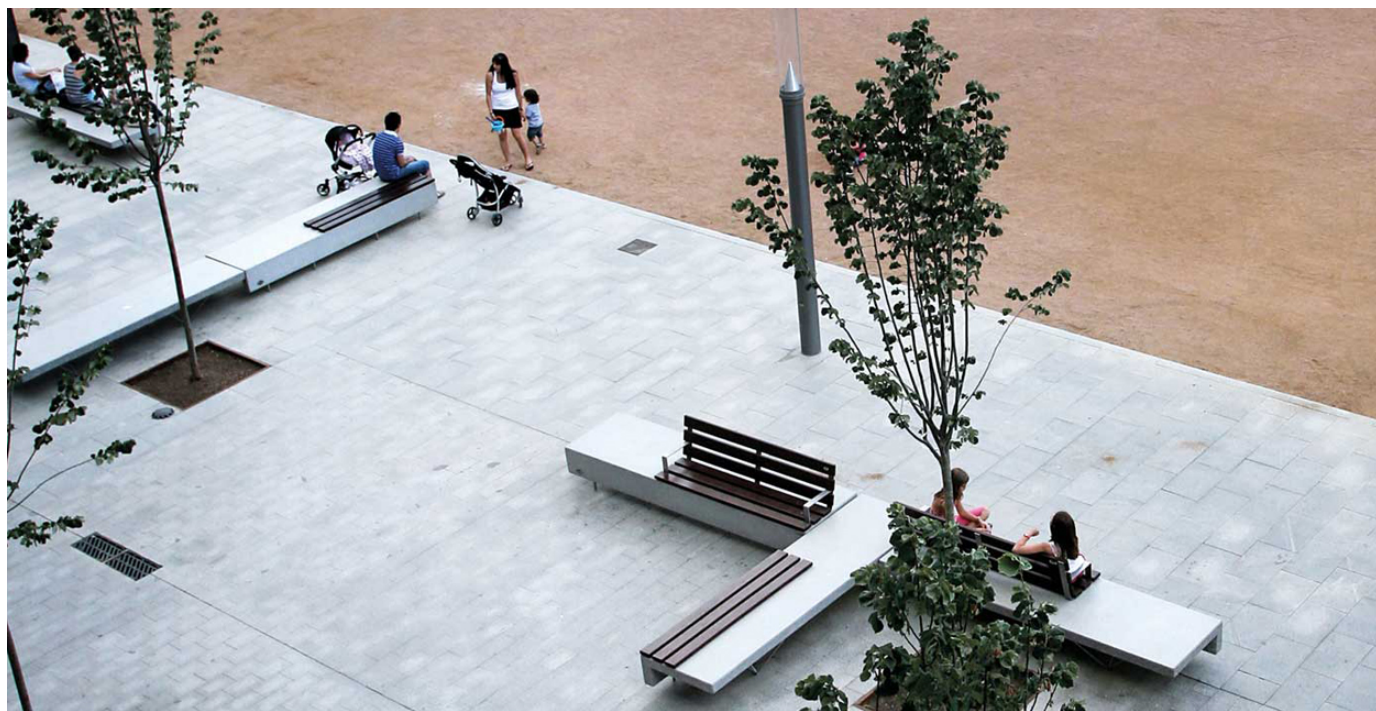

Benches from the Ela collection were installed. To carry out this project, the architects team chose the benches from the Ela collection, which are made of concrete combined with tropical wood. This collection is characterised by its minimalist shapes ideal for all types of environments. In order to light the square, **Simetrika luminaires** were chosen. They consist of a very minimalist cylindrical light point made of aluminium. Moreover, the optic group is located on top of the luminaire, thus reducing luminous pollution.
