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In the Ponte a Greve Garden, in Florence, Italy, a new playground has been installed, built with Robinia wood. This type of wood stands out for its high resistance and durability, as well as being maintenance-free, making it an ideal option for public spaces. The park has been designed to naturally integrate into the surrounding green environment, respecting the landscape and providing a welcoming space for play and social interaction. Among the elements that make up the park are a large modular play structure allowing for multiple activities, a balance game that stimulates motor coordination, a spring rocker for younger children, classic swings, and an interactive musical panel that invites creativity. This installation represents a commitment to outdoor, sustainable, and accessible play, encouraging children's interaction with nature and with other kids from the neighborhood.
